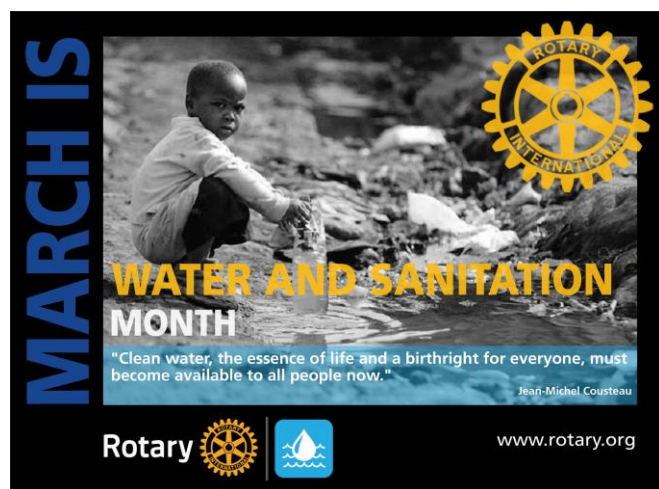

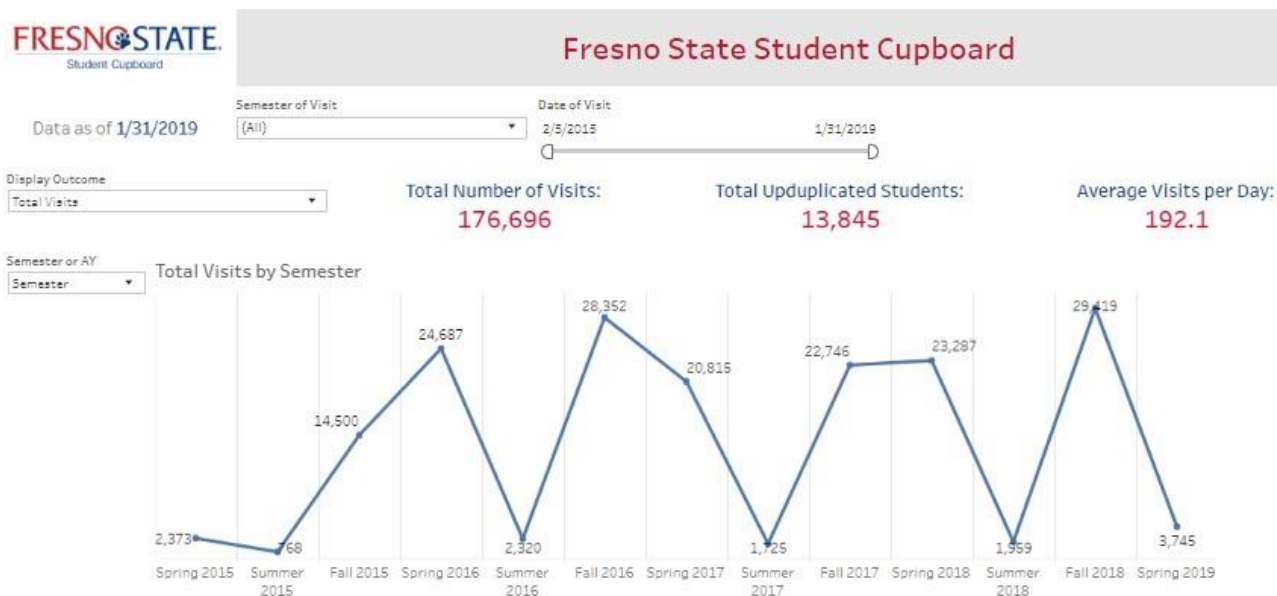


Fresno State | March Match Up

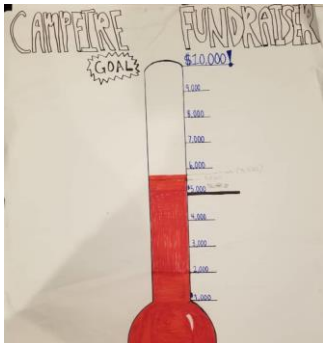
